# Community Updates

**Multi-Purpose Room Changes-** The Master Board has approved the installation of three ceiling fans in the Lodge Multi-Purpose Room (MPR). This concept, and donation, was spearheaded by the Special Events Charter Club prior to their dissolution late last year.

**New 4-Way Stop-** In addition to the many other 4-way stops that are in the process of being installed throughout the community, the Master Board has also approved the addition of two stop signs at Walloon Way and Charlevoix which will create a 4-way stop.

**Women's Restroom-** After feedback from many homeowners, the Neighborhood Boards, Committees and Master Board have approved the installation of an auxiliary heater (very similar to the additional heater in the locker rooms) in the women's restroom within the Lodge. This process insures that the community standards are upheld, and that the contractor has completed the project correctly.

CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) is easy to learn and saves lives!!! Did you know that sudden cardiac arrest is one of the leading causes of death in the United States? Unfortunately, most people who suffer a cardiac arrest (outside of a hospital) do not get CPR from a bystander, which can significantly lessen their chances of survival. Another fact, more than 85 percent of cardiac arrests take place at home. Not only is CPR easy to learn but even hands-only CPR has been found to be helpful before emergency services arrive. If you don't know CPR, learn CPR and gain some confidence in knowing that if you are ever needed, you too can save a life!

EMT, Carl McKinney, is an instructor from the American Heart Association and will be here Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup> at 10am to certify you on CPR and First Aid. Bridgewater cost is only \$40. (Class costs typically \$90-\$113.)

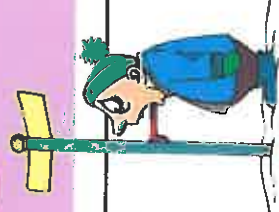
